

SHOW RULES AND INFORMATION

1) This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the BSPS, including disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. All Rules as per the 2024 BSPS Rule & Show handbook. See BSPS website (www.bsps.com) for any amendments.

2) Neither the BSPS or any of its officers, assistants or stewards shall in any way be responsible for any loss, injury or damages that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought onto the Showground or on any premises used in conjunction with the Show, or while entering or leaving the same.

It is necessary all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance for an adequate Indemnity to protect against their negligence including any injury caused by their animals or property

3) All horses and ponies must be four years old or over. <u>*NOTE - No animal can be brought onto the</u> showground unless it is entered in a class within this schedule *

4) This is a qualifying show for the **BSPS SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW to be held in August** 2024 at Arena UK, Allington Lane, Allington, Grantham, Lincs. NG322EF

QUALIFICATION FOR THE B.S.P.S. SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW

5) The 1st and 2nd placed animals in classes 7, 24 & 25. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd in classes 6 & 45 The 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th in mixed classes 4, 23 & 43 will qualify for the BSPS Championship Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 21 and 26 and ridden by a BSPS member.

6)THE BSPS "BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES" AREA BEST RIDER CHAMPIONSHIPS This

Championship class will be held at the 2024 BSPS Summer Championship Show. There will be one class for riders not to have attained their 25th Birthday before 1st January in the current year. **Riders must be registered with the BSPS and be a member of BSPS AREA 15 to compete.**

7)THE BSPS CHALLENGE" This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Challenge. Animals competing in the following Open classes will qualify :- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, Cradle & Nursery Stakes, WHP, Intermediate SRT, SH & WH, and Open Heritage M&M Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes. Classes 4, 6, 7, 14, 23, 24, 25, 30, 31, 35, 40, 43 & 45

8a) <u>THE BSPS BINKS FAMILY CHAMPIONS OF CHAMPIONS</u> This show is a qualifier for the BSPS The Binks Family Champion Of Champions. <u>The 1st prize winners</u> in the following classes will qualify- Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT, & WH, Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & WHP classes. <u>8b) THE BSPS</u>
<u>BINKS FAMILY MINI WHP CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS</u>. This show is a qualifier for the BSPS The Binks Family Mini WHP Champion Of Champions. <u>The 1st prize winners</u> in Open Cradle and Nursery Stakes will qualify. Classes 6 & 7

9) BSPS RULES- Riders must be 12 years old and over on 1st January in the current year to ride any pony stallion not exceeding 138cms or Small Breed M&M Stallions i.e. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A & B. Riders must be 14 years old and over on 1st January in the current year to ride any Stallion exceeding 138cms or Large Breed M&M Stallions i.e. Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Section C & D.

10) HATS - UPDATE AS PER RULE 43 IN THE 2024 RULE BOOK Correctly secured skull caps/riding hats nos. PAS015 2011,VGI,(BS) EN1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 & 2023, SNELL E2016 & E2021, AS/NZS 3838 2006 MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted. Hats should have a plain cover either Black, Navy Blue, Brown, Grey or Green, velvet covers are encouraged. The BSPS encourages members to have their hats tagged through the BSPS scheme or via the Pony Club scheme. Tagging indicates that the hat meets the accepted standards. No check of the fit or condition of the hat is implied. It is considered to be the responsibility of the members/guardians to ensure the hat complies with the current standards and is tagged before they compete. Hat tagging in BSPS classes is compulsory at BSPS Winter, Summer and Heritage Championship shows, RIHS, LIHS, Burghley Gold Cup & Lead rein WSP final. (We are accepting British Eventing, British Riding Cub & Pony Club tags.)

11) BODY PROTECTORS - MUST BE COMPLIANT WITH RULE 50 IN THE 2024 BSPS RULE

<u>BOOK</u> They must be worn when jumping in any WHP & WH classes, including in the practice ring at B.S.P.S. affiliated Shows. (Including Tiny Tots, Cradle & Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes.) Riders must wear a body protector when working in (practise jumps) and the jumping phase in all B.S.P.S. organised and affiliated events. <u>A BETA approved and appropriately labelled "Level 3</u> **body protector" 2018 (Blue and Black) shown on lable.** BETA recommends body protectors are replaced at least every three to five years, after which the impact absorption properties of the foam may have started to decline. All types of Air Jackets are NOT allowed.

12) Only tack that is permissible in the ring in BSPS classes is allowed to be used on the showground when mounted.

13). This Show is run with due regard to Health and Safety. The primary contact on the day will be Mrs. Sue Johnson. It is in the best interests of all exhibitors and spectators that they comply with any request, verbal or written, from any Show Official which pertains to Health and Safety matters. Any accident must be reported to a Show Official as soon as possible. First Aiders/ Medics will be on duty for all classes.

14) Animals may not compete in both the 153cms WHP Class and the Intermediate WH class at the same show, in the same section, except at the RIHS.

<u>The B.S.P.S. Training Stakes WHP classes. (Classes 1, 2, 5 & 12)</u> <u>These classes are Open to Plaited Animals and Heritage (M&M) Ponies</u> Animals may be entered in more than one class in this section.

Method of Judging - animals will be required to jump a course of fences, they will immediately be asked to give a short show including a change of rein and gallop in the same ring. Marks :- Jumping 60 points, Style & Manners while jumping 20 points, Show mark & Manners 20points. TOTAL 100 points. Ponies may not be shown on the Lead Rein. Any Suitable Tack.

Class 1 <u>The B.S.P.S. Training Stakes</u> Animals 4yrs or over. Rider any age. Maximum height of fences 70cms

Class 2 <u>The B.S.P.S. Training Stakes</u> Animals 4yrs and over. Rider any age. Maximum height of fences 80cms

Class 3 <u>The B.S.P.S. Mixed Height Novice WHP/Intermediate W.H.</u> Mare or gelding 4 yrs. or over not exceeding 158cms. Riders MUST jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section (see rule 37). Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cm or the Intermediate Section.

Small height ponies will jump first. <u>Please state height of pony on entry form.</u> (NEW - Please note new Area 15 WHP championship following class 4)

Class 4 <u>The B.S.P.S. Mixed Height Open WHP/Intermediate W.H.</u> Mare or gelding, 4 yrs or and over not exceeding 158cms. Riders MUST jump in their correct height section and be the correct age for the height of the animal they ride. Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section. (see rule 37) Riders must declare if they are competing in the 153cm or the Intermediate Section. Large height ponies will jump first <u>Please state height of pony on entry form</u> (NEW – note championship that follows class 4) <u>The WINNER of class 4 will qualify for The BSPS The Binks Family Champion of Champions</u>

Class 7 <u>The B.S.P.S. Open Nursery Stakes.</u> Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding **133**cms. Riders not to have attained their <u>12th Birthday</u> before 1st January in the current year.

Riders may ride more than one pony providing the animals are of a different height section. Starting with the <u>large height ponies first</u>. <u>Please state height of pony on entry form</u> <u>The WINNER of class 14 will qualify for the BSPS The Binks Family Champion of</u> <u>Champions</u> <u>Class 14 is also a Qualifier for Equifest</u>
